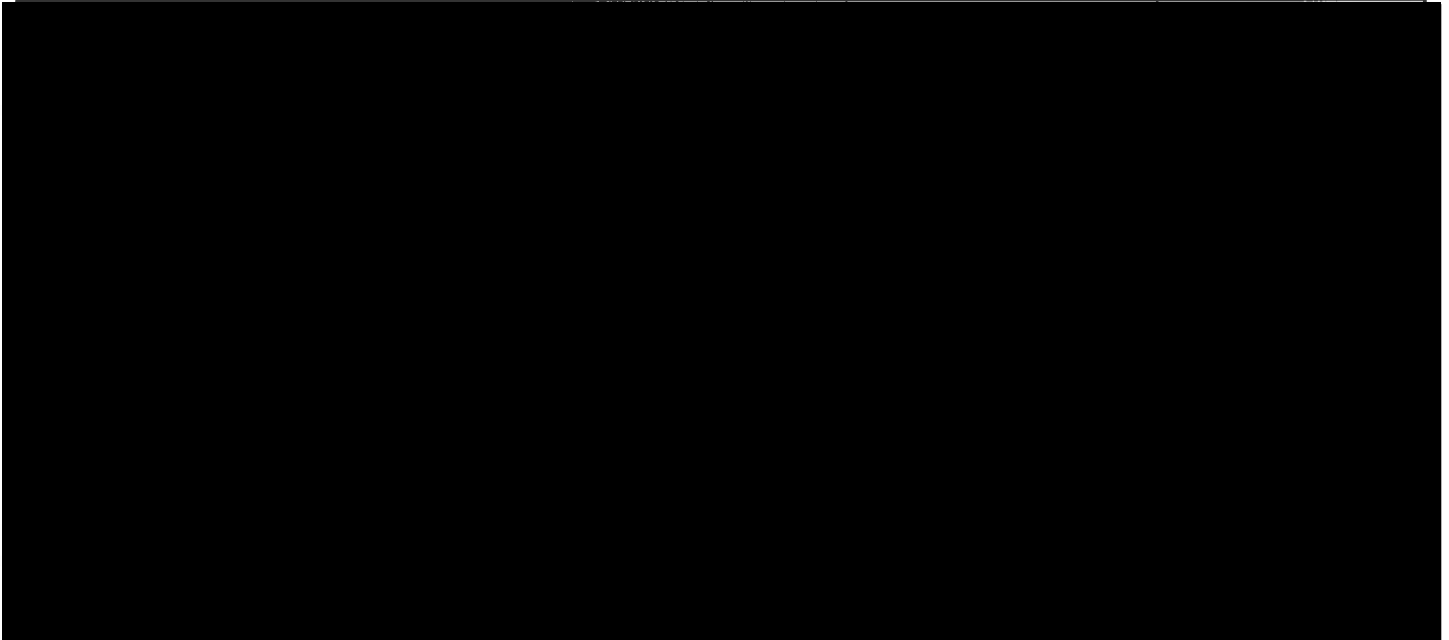

Graduate Demographics






Employment Status by Gender



Employer Types by Age at Graduation





Employer Detail by Gender




Employer Detail by Gender

Employment Status by Race/Ethnicity





Employer Types by Race/Ethnicity





Private Practice Detail by Race/Ethnicity





Employer Detail by Race/Ethnicity



Employer Detail by Race/Ethnicity



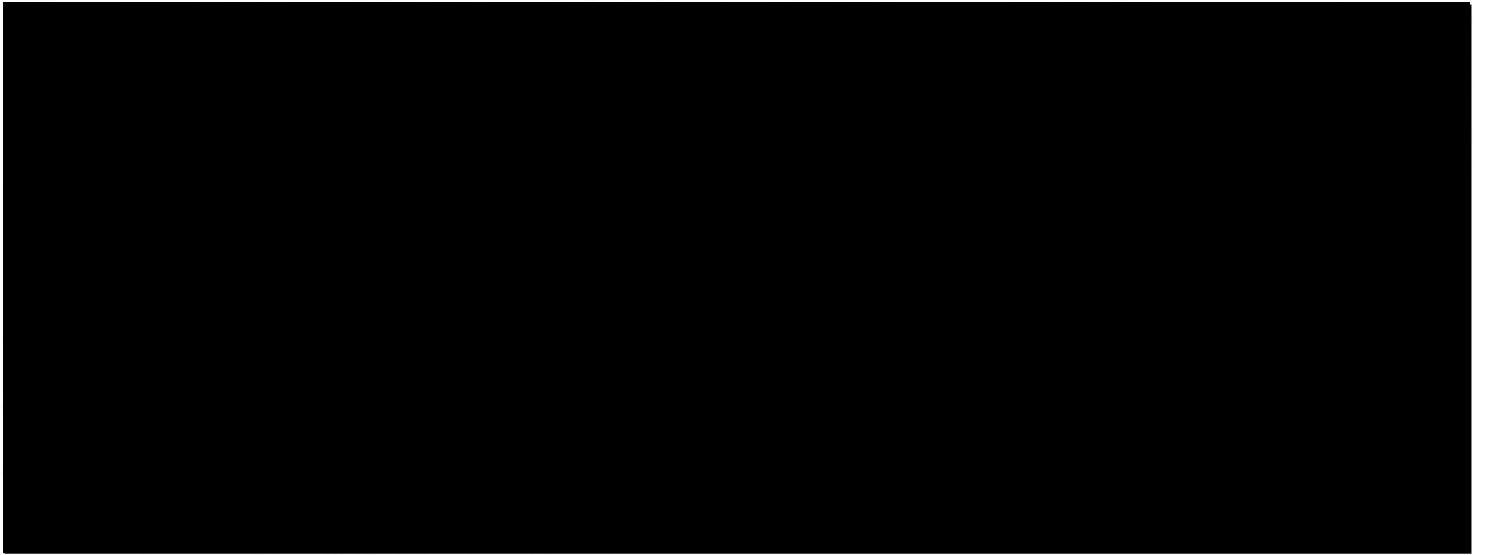
